

The BEST Reusable Beeswax Wrap kit

Contents: 3 pieces of 100% cotton fabric, pre-mixed wax block and these instructions.

1. Cover an ironing board with a sheet of greaseproof paper larger than your biggest piece of fabric.
2. Place fabric piece (or pieces, depending on size) flat on greaseproof paper.
3. Grate some of the wax block onto the surface of your fabric. Place another sheet of parchment on top and use a medium hot iron to melt the wax and move it round the fabric till coated. It's easy to oversaturate, so remember that it's easier to add more than take the excess away.
4. Place the next wrap(s) you are going to make on top of the finished fabric to soak up any excess coating mixture. Work quickly, as you don't want the wax to begin to solidify.
5. Once you've pressed any excess onto the new cloth, peel apart and hang your completed wrap(s) to dry. Drying only takes a few minutes.
6. Repeat steps with additional pieces of fabric until you are out of coating mixture or fabric.
7. If any of the block is left after the 3 pieces of fabric is covered, set aside to use as a refresher block in a few months time.
